





Encore Parkway Bridge & Streetscape

CID Contribution \$6,000,000

Total Project Cost \$17,900,000

Project Partners

City Of Alpharetta Georgia Department of Transportation Atlanta Regional Commission State Road and Tollway Authority

The Encore Parkway Corridor Improvement project transformed Encore Parkway into a multimodal corridor.

The new roadway includes two travel lanes, two 6-foot bicycle lanes and two 8-foot sidewalks with landscaped buffers on each side and a raised, landscaped median.

The North Fulton CID cut the ribbon on Encore Parkway on June 28, 2017.

Northwinds Parkway **Extension**

CID Contribution \$2,000,000

Total Project Cost \$6,000,000

Project Partners

Georgia Department of Transportation City Of Alpharetta

This project was completed in 2017 as a joint effort to build out Northwinds Parkway, which previously ended at Kimball Bridge Road, to Old Milton Parkway.

The extension improves connectivity within the City of Alpharetta and North Fulton, enhancing accessibility to the new Gwinnett Technical College of Alpharetta-North Fulton campus and Avalon.

The North Fulton CID cut the ribbon on the Northwinds Parkway Extension on August 29, 2017.




Before (above) and after (below) of the Northwinds Parkway Extension project at the intersection of Northwinds and Old Milton Parkway.

Windward Phase 2 Design

CID Contribution \$620,000

Total Project Cost \$6,000,000

Project Partners Georgia Department of Transportation State Road and Tollway Authority Fulton County City of Alpharetta

Windward Parkway Phase 2 will reduce congestion at the hightraffic Georgia 400 interchange at Windward Parkway by adding a triple-left-turn-lane to the northbound exit ramp. The additional lane will extend westbound along Windward Parkway to Deerfield Parkway and Westside Parkway. The project will also include adding a dual left-turn lane from Windward Parkway to Westside Parkway.

The project is part of an ongoing effort to improve transportation flow for drivers along and entering Windward Parkway from Georgia 400.

The North Fulton CID is funding design and construction management for the project.

Alpha Loop


CID Contribution \$250.000

The Alpha Loop is a multi-use path system designed to connect Downtown Alpharetta, Avalon and the Northwinds/North Point Activity Center.

The North Fulton CID authorized design funding for the segment of the Alpha Loop connecting Old Milton Parkway to Westside Parkway and the segment connecting Westside Parkway to Kimball Bridge Road.




